51. Grit bin filling & grit budget:

Somerset County Council have informed the Parish Council that they will no longer fill up any of the grit bins within the Parish, it will be up to the Parish Council to pay for the grit and fill the bins if that's a service they wish to take on.

The Parish Council has just purchased five new bins plus two are already in location. Members are asked to determine viable options for the installing and filling of the five new bins. Also, how the Parish Council can keep the bins full of grit throughout the winter, setting a budget accordingly and identifying where to virement the money from.

52. Dog bins

The new dog bins have now been installed in the agreed locations. Since then a few other locations have been identified as being desirable to have a bin. Members are asked to resolve if they would like to use the underspend for this project on buying more bins.

53. Bus shelters update:

Members are asked to approve the expense of £254 to make two retrospective adjustments to the planning permission for the bus shelters, first to change the material used from oak to soft wood, second to move the red box on the map on the Frome side one metre north.

54. Draft budget for 2019/20:
